C4T 5 Steps to Prepare for DMS

Declarants need to prepare for the decommission of AGS and GPA.

- If your business has not already done so, register with the <u>Dutch</u> <u>Chamber of Commerce</u>
 - A copy of the <u>application form EMR</u> needs to be sent to the Dutch customs authorities
 - **Authorisations might need to be adjusted** and renewed for DMS 4.0 and DMS 4.1. If this is not done, the current set-up might not be valid anymore, leading to delays in transitioning.
- Make sure you know what data needs to be sent to customs authorities when transitioning from AGS/GPA to DMS, and that you are able to do so by the deadline. This is the data that customs need to validate your declaration.
 Note: Data requirements are more extensive in DMS compared to AGS or GPA/SPA.
 - **Choose what types of declarations you want to use** and assess how you can optimise your declaration flows and processes, *for example*, will you lodge a standard declaration or use the Entry in the Declarant Records (EIDR)?
